

A Facilities and associated services currently operated by Doddinghurst Parish Council

- 1 Burial Ground for Doddinghurst, Wyatts Green and Hook End residents
- 2 Allotment provision (45 off) to Doddinghurst, Wyatts green and Hook End residents.
- 3 Peartree General Purpose recreational field, 4.4 acres with field gate entrance from highway
- 4 Senior and Junior Football Fields on "Budgen Fields". Also Village Hall Junior Football field
- 5 Enclosed Children's Play Area for children up to the age of 14
- 6 A general recreational field adjacent the Scouting Group facilities with Teen Village, Kicking Goal, Basket Ball and Petanque space as well as large slide.
- 7 A small car park adjacent play areas and access to pitches
- 8 ** Parish building semi detached to the Village Hall containing an office, toilets, sports changing rooms, showers, referees room
and Parish Room - used for meetings and public hire. Office IT and equipment.
- 9 Parish Footpaths as a member of ECC P3 scheme.
- 10 Liaison with Village Tree Wardens
- 11 Litter bins and Dog Litter bins associated with items (1), (3), (4), (5) and (6) *.
- 12 Mowing, strimming, weeding, feeding, hedge cutting and tree management associated with (1), (3), (4), (5) and (6)*.
- 13 Nature Trail circumnavigating Football Fields
- 14 Pond and Doddinghurst Village sign at Peartree Green
- 15 Bus Shelters - general repairs and servicing
- 16 Notice Boards - 3 off plus cemetery.
- 17 Parish Council and Community Website
- 18 Village Events and Newsletters
- 19 Police and Neighbourhood Watch liaison.
- 20 Village Bus Club for monthly trip to places of interest.
- 21 Risk Assessments and Safety Checks for all facilities including Parish Building that needs power, emergency lighting, fire, water and security checks.
- 22 Winter Grit storage

* Note: Brentwood Borough Council Parks and Cleansing services paid to undertake elements of items 11 and 12 above

B Services currently carried out by Brentwood Borough Council

- 1 Grass cutting of Pavement Verges and other green spaces eg Peartree Green
- 2 Road sweeping
- 3 Road gully cleaning
- 4 Deep cleaning of pavements, including weedkiller on pavements, and washing road signs
- 5 Domestic refuse and recycling collections.
- 6 Road sign replacement when damaged.
- 7 Clearing overgrown shrubbery affecting pavements etc.
- 8 Removal of abandoned cars.
- 9 Litter removal from highway including fly tipping
- 10 Pest Control (being withdrawn)
- 11 Legal and other advice services such as arbourcultural.

C Services currently carried out by Essex County Council

- 1 Bus Shelter replacement
- 2 Minor Highway repairs - potholes, road marking, road signs and road nameplates, kerb replacements and verge bollards, ditch and culvert clearing.
- 3 Major Highway works - New works, Resurfacing pavements and roads, Road Drainage, Crossings and Lighting
- 4 Speed limit legislative documentation and signage
- 5 Road Gritting
- 6 VAS signs

Note: All above excludes items such as Housing, Education, Planning, and Social Care which are T2 and T3 responsibilities
