Welcome to the Winter issue of the Parish Council Newsletter.

Doddinghurst Parish Council consists of 11 Parish Councillors who each serve a 4-year term of office, but many have served multiple terms over many years.

The Parish Council looks after the following in the village:

- Play areas and public open spaces including ponds, trees and some footpaths.
- Allotments in Mountnessing Lane.
- The cemetery ashes and burial plots.
- Flower tubs.
- Bus shelters

Parish Council services are paid for by a precept (paid by each household as part of your Council Tax Bill).

The next Parish Council elections for Doddinghurst will be held in 2024.

Parish Council Meetings

Parish Councillors meet monthly as a full Council and periodically as committees and welcome members of the public who wish to attend. Play Area

The Children's Play Area continues to be well used.

The play area is inspected daily and all litter is collected by our Groundsman. Brentwood Borough Council empties the bins for us.

The costs of cleaning up and repairs are paid for by the Council with funds from your Council tax and this reduces the amount we can spend elsewhere in the Parish.

Car Park

The surface of the small car park next to the play area had become uneven and was re-surfaced in September.

Parish Office Refurbishment
